Brand New Kick Off 2nd Headlining Tour of the US in Support of *Deja Entendu* (Triple Crown/Razor & Tie) on October 30th in Washington DC

New York, NY – **Brand New** kick off their second US headlining tour in support of *Deja Entendu*. The tour begins on October 30th at the 9:30 Club in DC and closes with a homecoming show in NYC on November 28th at Roseland with **Eisley** and **Hot Rod Circuit** opening for the entire tour. This will be Brand New's fourth consecutive tour in support of *Deja Entendu* since its mid-summer release. The band has already completed one US headlining tour, three weeks on this summer's *Warped Tour* and a US tour with **Dashboard Confessional**. Relentless touring and a superb sophomore album helped the band earn critical praise and sell out shows across the US.

Raved The *New York Times*... "Now the group has returned with "Déja Entendu" (Triple Crown/Razor & Tie), an extraordinary album full of riddles and rallying cries and contagious choruses. Jesse Lacey, the singer and songwriter, is starting to figure out what he's capable of, and his best songs are as good as any you'll hear all year."

Brand New was featured in *Rolling Stone's* annual "Hot Issue" where they were chosen as 2003's "Hot Band" (last year it was Coldplay). The band will also be featured on the cover of *Alternative Press'* December issue and recently completed a photo shoot and interview with *Spin* for a story in the January '04 issue.

The single "The Quiet Things That No One Ever Knows" remains in rotation at MTV, MTV2, and FUSE and continues to climb the alternative radio chart. "The Quiet Things..." has been enjoying success on stations like KROQ/LA, WXRK/NY and WBCN/Boston. The second single "Sic Transit Gloria...Glory Fades" is set to impact radio in early November. The video was recently shot in Los Angeles with Director Marc Webb (**Puddle Of Mudd**, **Santana**, **AFI**). In addition, **Brand New** made their National TV debut on *Jimmy Kimmel Live* (9/24), where they performed "The Quiet Things..." and "Sic Transit..." On the night of the performance, the ABC program attracted its largest audience on any night since the beginning of April!

Deja Entendu – out June 17th on Triple Crown/Razor & Tie - is the band's second full-length CD and has already surpassed 160,000 scanned, debuting on the *Billboard* Top 200 at #63. Below is a list of confirmed dates:
